Year 11 Mock exam re-sits Monday 14 – Thursday 17 December

The purpose of the re-sits is to provide your child with an opportunity to address any identified area of weakness so that your child continues to progress towards meeting his/her target grades. This will also be an opportunity for your child to sit any mock exams missed due to illness.
