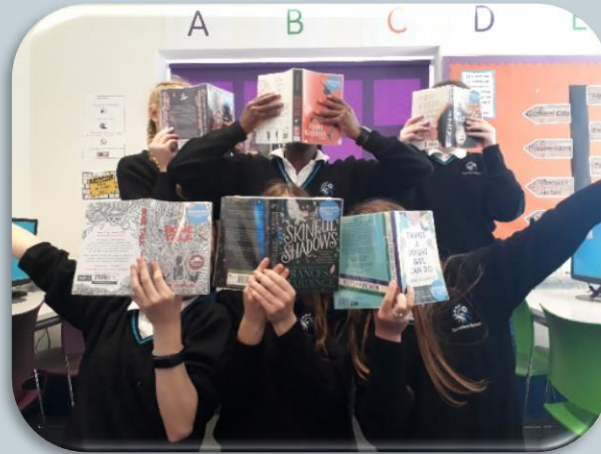

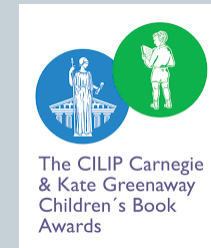


- **When are you open?**

- **How do we use the library?**

- You will come to the library in one of your English lessons in September when I will show you to find everything, how to borrow things, and how to log on to the library site online and read e-books etc.
- We have lots of resources that you can browse and borrow, including:
 - Fiction books in lots of genres (including manga/graphic novels)
 - Careers books
 - Mental health and teen books
 - General interest books and magazines
 - Non-fiction for all the subject areas (including biographies)
 - DVDs
 - E-books and audio books
- You can borrow up to 5 books for 2 weeks and/or a DVDs for 3 days



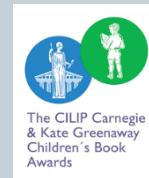
Library FAQs
