



Job Description – Accelerated Learning Provision - Tutor

Reports to: Accelerated Learning Provision – Lead Tutor

Purpose of the post:

The post holder is responsible for delivering tutoring and support to small groups of students largely, but not exclusively, in English, maths and science, as part of our accelerated learning provision. This is a form of intensive catch-up tutoring, and students receive this tutoring in addition to their usual lessons in these subjects.

Core Responsibilities

- Plan, manage, operate and evaluate each personalised alternative learning programme.
- Collate and plan a curriculum of study that meets the needs of each individual student.
- Provide a positive, safe learning environment that enables students with particular barriers to achieve.
- Work in collaboration with the Accelerated Learning Provision Lead Tutor to identify and implement the most appropriate alternative learning programme for each individual.
- Act as an advocate for students completing alternative learning programmes to all stakeholders.
- Liaise with the ALP Lead Tutor, House teams and subject teachers regularly as appropriate.
- Track and monitor the progress of all students completing alternative programmes, identifying needs of intervention to ensure success, by completing termly impact reports for the students.
- Support and tutor key students under the alternative learning programme on a daily basis, as needed.
- Provide support to students under the care of the wider team (including the House and Edison teams) when needed.
- Track and monitor the progress of all students completing ALP by completing termly impact reports.
- Support key students under the ALP on a daily basis, as needed.
- Provide a positive, safe learning environment that enables students with particular barriers to achieve.
- Have high expectations of all students and motivate the hardest to reach students and ensure a high level of engagement in all tutoring sessions.
- Instil a culture of hard work and ambition.

This job description details responsibilities but is not prescriptive and does not direct any particular priorities or amount of time to be spent carrying out the duties. It is not necessarily a comprehensive definition of the post. This job description may be subject to amendment in order to meet the changing needs of the school, following appropriate consultation.
