Welcome to the new term of Kids College. Once again, we are pleased to invite children in Years 5 and 6 to choose from our range of courses in technology and the arts. If you're coming up to Denefield next September, why not come and make some new friends before you start? **Please note: this is the last Kids College @ Denefield course this academic year.**



Like many schools, Denefield is facing significant financial challenges. We do not get government funding for children below Year 7 and so we are unable to continue to subsidise Kids College, as to do so would mean our own students missing out on the funding given to support their education.

We do, however, appreciate how popular and invaluable Kids College is for the transition process, so we would like to continue to offer it. We have therefore decided that, if Kids College @ Denefield is to continue, parents/carers will need to contribute £26.00 to the cost of the five week course (this amount is non-refundable). This will cover all five sessions, including ingredients and resources. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, you should contact their primary school in the first instance, to see if they can help with financial support.

Please have a look through the prospectus, make your choice then complete and submit your application form by **8.00am on Monday 9 February**. Places are limited on each course to a maximum of 16 students and will be allocated by ballot after the reply deadline.

Successful applicants will be notified during the week commencing Monday 9 February, payment will be required to secure the place (further information on how to pay will be sent with the notification).

# Can Cook, Will Cook (x2)



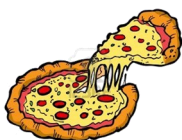
Calling all Jamie Olivers or Mary Berrys... if you enjoy eating and working with food, come and join the 'Can Cook, Will Cook' course.
