



Celebrating Denefield Friday 25 November 2022











It was fantastic to see so many Year 11s and their parents/carers at our Sixth Form Open Evening on Thursday, along with many students from nearby schools. Denefield is rightly proud of its exciting Sixth Form, with expert teaching, small class sizes and fantastic extra-curricular and leadership opportunities. Denefield Sixth Form students get great results – 82% of them gained grades A*-C last year – and continue on to impressive destinations, including Oxbridge and Russell Group universities, and to top-level apprenticeships. We have already started receiving our first applications for Sixth Form places for September 2023; our Sixth Form prospectus will be available on our website shortly.

Our assemblies this week have been led by Mrs Williams, who is our Designated Safeguarding Lead. Mrs Williams focused on staying safe



online, in particular knowing who it is that you are in contact with, never sharing personal information, and never meeting in person someone you only know online.
